

FIGHTING THE FLU... DURING A PANDEMIC

Flu season is upon us- but this year, flu meets COVID-19. We received 120 doses of flu vaccines in October, and our patients are proudly getting vaccinated and encouraging others to do the same. The clinic is providing free vaccines to anyone without insurance. Just call for an appointment!

Protecting yourself from the flu will reduce flu-related sickness and hospitalization, decreasing the strain on healthcare workers who are caring for COVID-19 patients.

Even if you are vaccinated and still get sick, the flu vaccine can reduce the severity of your illness, so make sure to get a flu vaccine now if you have not gotten vaccinated yet this season!


December 1st is an opportunity for you to instantly and directly contribute to our mission. WHY?


